Sermon Handout: Our Father, Week 9

Main Points:

1. **Foundation Matters:** Just as a house needs a solid foundation, our lives need the right foundation. The authoritative teaching of Jesus is the foundation that leads to righteous and everlasting life.

2. **Two Paths:** Jesus presents two paths: the narrow path leading to life and the broad path leading to destruction (Matthew 7:13-14). Entrance into God's Kingdom is solely through Jesus.

3. **False Prophets and True Fruit:** Beware of false prophets who appear righteous but lead people astray (Matthew 7:15-20). True disciples are recognized by their transformed lives and love for one another.

4. **True Discipleship:** Not everyone who calls Jesus "Lord" will enter the Kingdom of Heaven, but only those who do the will of the Father (Matthew 7:21-23). True disciples know Jesus and are known by Him through a genuine relationship.

5. **Building on the Rock:** Jesus concludes with the parable of the wise and foolish builders (Matthew 7:24-27). Building our lives on Jesus' teachings ensures stability and endurance through life's storms.

Bottom Line: Build your life on the solid rock of Jesus' words.

Application:

- Examine the cost. Have you paid a price to profess faith in Christ?
- Investigate the change. Are there godly fruits from your life?
- Remember: True faith in Christ will last, not only in the storms of life, but also in the final judgment.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1. What does it mean to build your life on the foundation of Jesus' teachings?
- 2. How can we recognize false prophets or false teachers and ensure we are following true teachings?
- 3. Why is it important to have a genuine relationship with Jesus rather than just knowing about Him?
- 4. How can we ensure that our lives bear good fruit that reflects our faith in Jesus?
- 5. What steps can we take as a family to strengthen our foundation in Christ and withstand life's storms?
