Made for Generosity By Paul Webster

Main Points:

1. **Generosity is commanded by God.** God commands His people to be generous, as seen in Deuteronomy 15:7-8. Generosity is woven into the fabric of the Church's identity.

2. **Generosity brings blessings.** Generosity benefits both the giver and the receiver. True blessings are not just material but also spiritual and emotional.

3. Understanding God's Generosity for Us Leads to More Generosity by Us. Recognizing God's generosity helps us reflect His character in our own lives. God's ultimate act of generosity is giving His Son, Jesus Christ (John 3:16).

Bottom Line: Those who know Jesus must make Jesus known to the world.
